Keep your phone on!

Your nearest Regional Mobiliser will get in touch for a chat. Your contacts will be available to other Regional Mobilisers and other Local Leaders – you'll get the details of everyone else from your Regional Mobiliser.

Think action.

You'll need to think about what you want to do over the next year, and set a target with your Regional Mobiliser. It doesn't have to be much, but it does have to be something that will help change our world. A 10k, a club night, a flash mob?

Get creative.

All Local Leaders should aim to raise £250 a year. That's about what it costs to support two people to change their lives with Progressio. Get thinking about the kinds of things you'd like to do to raise it!

Be ready.

From time to time you'll get campaign actions from Progressio by email or in the post. You can post the email ones on Facebook or email them to your friends and family. Some might be special actions that you'll need to take to your community.

Get your diary out.

There might already be some dates to get in your calendar, especially any training, festivals or events. Put them in now!

how can I make it happen?

There are a lot of ways to play your part in tackling poverty around the world. Whether you want to tell stories from your own experiences, hold an event to raise awareness of an issue you care about, hold the world's greatest fundraiser, get together with other Local Leaders near you for a well-earned drink, or have an idea for some training that you think would make a big difference to you, it's all possible.

How about these 3 steps?

Step 1

Call your Regional Mobiliser. Life's easier if you get help. They can help you think through your idea and what help you'll need. And they have some money too, so that might be useful.

Step 2

Get some resources. There are resources to help you at progressio. org.uk/empower on all kinds of topics. If you need a how-to on event promotion, or a primer on HIV and AIDS, everything is there. Don't have something? Contact campaigns@progressio.org.uk

Step 3

Tell other people. You'll have Local Leader contact details – why not give some people near you a ring and see if they want to help?

As a Local Leader you'll already have a load of amazing specific skills and knowledge about international development generally. Much of it will have been finessed overseas on voluntary placements. You are already awesome.

But sometimes we're out of practice, need a booster or don't know something. That's totally fine, and there are a few places where you can get what you need.

The Local Leader Winter Weekender

Open to all Local Leaders, the Winter Weekender will give you new skills and knowledge, or refreshers, in most of what you need. It's the kick-off for the Empower year and includes skills development, improving topic knowledge, amazing speakers, time for reflection, time for planning in regions and social time. **Be there.**

Through the year, Local Leaders are also invited to a small number of days organised by the Regional Mobilisers in collaboration with Progressio HQ staff. Watch out for those.
