PLANNING YOUR EVENT

FIRST STEPS

- Who will you invite?
- When will the event take place?
- Which venue will you use? Estimate how many people will attend to work out
 how much space you will need. The village hall, church, local pub or your own living
 room are all good options. Two rounds require sound and video, so make sure you
 have a screen and speakers available.

Once you've decided, get the word out quickly to reach as many people as possible.

PLANNING A LARGER-SCALE ZIMFARE MEAL?

Could your **parish** host a large ZimFare event for the local community? Perhaps your **schoo**l or **university society** could organise a fundraising lunch?

LET PEOPLE KNOW!

- Use **posters** to advertise in the local community.
- Feature your ZimFare event in local newsletters and local media.
- Use social media. Create a Facebook event and invite your friends and family.
 Mention @ProgressioUK (Facebook), @Progressio (Twitter) and #ZimFare16 so we can retweet and share! Also, include the venue's Facebook or Twitter in your posts to increase coverage.




